THE HIGHER EDUCATION PROGRAM PROVIDES SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS FOR ALASKA NATIVE AND AMERICAN INDIAN STUDENTS WHO ARE CITIZENS OF OVK, SERVED BY THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS, WHO ARE ENROLLED IN A DEGREE-GRANTING PROGRAM OF AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY, AND HAVE DEFINITE FINANCIAL NEED AFTER OTHER SOURCES OF FUNDS ARE APPLIED. STUDENTS WILL BE SERVED BASED ON ENROLLMENT AND NOT ON RESIDENCY. FULL TIME STUDENTS MUST MAINTAIN A 2.0 GPA AND CARRY 12 CREDITS AND PART-TIME STUDENTS MUST CARRY 6 CREDITS AND GRADUATE STUDENTS 9 CREDITS.

CITY OF KAKE SPECIAL ELECTIONS NOTICE OF ELECTIONS

THE CITY OF KAKE IS HOLDING A SPECIAL ELECTION ON TUESDAY DECEMBER 17TH, 2024.

DOC (DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY) FORMS MAY BE OBTAINED FROM THE CITY OFFICE.

CANDIDATES MUST BE:

- A QUALIFIED VOTER & RESIDENT OF THE CITY OF KAKE
- AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD AT THE TIME OF FILING
- NOT CONSIDERED DELINQUENT IN PAYMENT OF ANY SALES TAX, UTILITY BILL, HARBOR BILL, OR ANY OTHER FINANCIAL OBLIGATION FOR THE TERM OF OFFICE
- A RESIDENT OF THE CITY FOR AT LEAST ONE YEAR PRECEDING THE ELECTION DAY IN THE CASE OF THE COUNCIL MENER; AND
- A RESIDENT OF THE CITY FOR AT LEAST THIRTY DAYS
 PRECEDING THE ELECTION IN THE CASE OF THE
 SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER

THE FOLLOWING SEATS ARE OPEN:

- KAKE MAYOR SEAT A: 3 YR TERM
- KAKE CITY COUNCIL SEAT B: 3 YR TERM
- KAKE CITY COUNCIL SEAT C: 3 YR TERM
